CHANGES TO COVID-19 RELATED ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVEL TO THE BAHAMAS

VACCINATED TRAVELLERS

Effective 19 June 2022 fully vaccinated travellers will no longer be required to submit to pre-travel COVID-19 testing to enter the country.

- Instead, valid proof of vaccination must be presented before boarding a flight to The Bahamas.
- COVID-19 testing is no longer required for persons travelling inter-island (domestic) within The Bahamas, regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status (unvaccinated or fully vaccinated)

UNVACCINATED TRAVELLERS

- Through Saturday, 18 June 2022, unvaccinated travellers, ages 12 and older, entering The Bahamas must obtain a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR Test (including PCR, NAA, NAAT, TMA or RNA) test taken **no more than three days (72 hours)** prior to the date of arrival.
- Through Saturday, 18 June 2022, unvaccinated children between the ages of 2 and 11 are required to obtain a negative COVID-19 test (either a Rapid Antigen Test or RT-PCR Test), taken **no more than three days (72 hours)** prior to the date of arrival to The Bahamas.

Effective 19 June 2022, all unvaccinated travellers ages 2 and older will be required to obtain a negative COVID-19 test — either a negative RT-PCR test or a Rapid Antigen test — taken no more than three days (72 hours) prior to travel and present the negative test results at check-in before travel to The Bahamas.

- Children under the age of 2 are exempt from any testing requirements.
- COVID-19 testing is no longer required for persons travelling inter-island (domestic) within The Bahamas, regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status (unvaccinated or fully vaccinated).
