

In 2016, the country hosted the 25th Annual CWWA Conference and Exhibition; It is therefore with great pleasure and much anticipation that the CWWA returns to the bustling city of Port of Spain to host this event under the auspices of the Government of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, in collaboration with the Ministry of Public Utilities.
