- Belize Water Services, San Pedro Reverse Osmosis Plant
- Hol Chan Marine Reserve, San Pedro

Date: Friday, October 24, 2025

Duration: Full Day (8:00 AM to 2:00 PM)

Description: Begin the day with an insightful tour of the Belize Water Services (BWS) San Pedro Reverse Osmosis Plant, where delegates will observe the innovative processes used to ensure clean, potable water. Experts will provide in-depth explanations on the desalination process. Then enjoy a scenic transfer to Hol Chan Marine Reserve, one of Belize's most celebrated protected areas. This part of the tour includes a guided snorkeling experience.

The plant's ability to produce up to 7 million gallons per day highlights BWS's commitment to quality, innovation, and 24/7 operations that ensure continuous and safe water supply. This is an opportunity to witness water treatment excellence in action and connect with the dedicated professionals who deliver water and more. Then explore the operations of Bowen & Bowen, Belize's iconic brewery, with a focus on its advanced wastewater treatment systems and sustainability practices. Get a behind-the-scenes look at how industrial facilities manage water reuse, treatment, and efficiency while upholding environmental standards.
